

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)



Pack Camping has come a long way and it is one of the strongest reasons boys join the Cub Scout program.



For a Pack to go camping however there **MUST** be at least one registered leader on the outing that is BALOO trained.

This one day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for those leaders who are interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO is an instructor-led course which is

conducted at the Council level. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience.

BALOO is a seven (7) hour outdoor training which helps with understanding the BSA progressive camping program. The training reviews guidelines established by the Boy Scouts of America and the Orange County Council to help us understand the value of the outdoor program.

Completion of this course is mandatory for at least one adult on a Pack overnigher.
