

# Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training

Research has shown that units that have trained leaders are more successful, and that the youth in those units benefit far more from the Scouting program. Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training (LST) is one of the two courses required for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters to be recognized as being “Trained” for the position.

The course covers the basics of how the Boy Scout program is supposed to work. Topics include Aims & Methods of Scouting, how to structure troop and annual planning activities, patrol method, role of the Scoutmaster, and others. The course also benefits parents and committee members, providing an understanding of what their youth should be doing (and what the adults should *not* be doing!).
